



## **Pilot study on freedom of choice: How to book an appointment to a general practitioner**

Persons aged 65 or over can see a private general practitioner for the same price as the local user fee charged by public healthcare. This pilot study on freedom of choice runs from 1 September 2025 to 31 December 2027.

## What kind of doctor can you book an appointment with?

You can see a private general practitioner who is participating in the pilot study. General practitioners treat people of all ages and a wide range of conditions. They will help you with problems such as back pain, trouble sleeping or high blood pressure.

## How do you book an appointment?

- Check which clinics are participating in the pilot study: [kela.fi/freedom-of-choice-pilot](http://kela.fi/freedom-of-choice-pilot).
- Book your appointment directly on the clinic's website. You can also choose a remote video or phone appointment.
- If you book your appointment by phone, tell the receptionist that you are booking an appointment that is included in the pilot study.

During the pilot study you can book 3 appointments per year.

## How much do the appointments, examinations and tests cost?

### Appointment with a private general practitioner

✓ you can book a doctor's appointment if you fall ill	✗ appointments with a specialist
✓ you get faster access to treatment	✗ health checks for example for age-related reasons or to get a medical certificate for your driver's licence
✓ you know the prices in advance	✗ services provided by a nurse.
✓ you pay less for certain examinations and tests.	

## Keep track of your appointments

Keep track of how many appointments you have used and how many you have left each year to avoid unexpected costs.

You can also see this information in the OmaKela e-service, but it will be updated with a delay.
